Frequently Asked Questions

1. What makes the 7000 Series unique?

Concealed vertical rods offer a minimalist appearance while still providing appropriate security. With top and bottom latches, the 7000 Series is a secure alternative to other lock types and is used extensively in double door applications where exit devices are not required.

2. Can I use the 7000 Series on fire doors?

Yes, the 7000 Series is UL listed for wood and metal fire-rated doors.



Yes, the 7000 Series is a great choice for double doors that do not require exit devices. As for door types, the 7000 Series is available for standard and narrow stile aluminum, metal and wood doors, and can be ordered without a bottom rod (NB option) for those applications where only top latching is required.

4. Can manual flush bolts be used in the same applications with the 7000 Series?

The International Building Code (IBC) does not permit manual flush bolts in occupied spaces in revisions 2003, 2006, 2009 and 2012 (with exceptions). However, you should check your local codes.

5. Does the 7000 Series replace the need for automatic flush bolts and coordinators?

Yes, the 7000 Series is the preferred option in locations where ADA compliance is a concern. The 7000 Series eliminates the need for multiple components at the door opening, reducing the mechanical overhead.

6. Is the 7000 Series windstorm rated?

Yes, the 7000 Series is UL listed for Windstorm and Hurricane metal door applications with the WS and HC options: ZHEM.R21744.

7. What are the electrified options for the 7000 Series?

The 7000 Series supports electrified trim, SARGENT Harmony™ Integrated Wiegand access control and electric latch retraction (ELR) options.

8. Can I use the electrified options for the 7000 Series with an automatic operator?

Yes, the 7000 Series with electric latch retraction (ELR) is a perfect complement for an auto operator when an exit device is not required. It can be used on pairs of doors or single doors. When used in a single door application with an automatic operator, the 7000 Series replaces electric strikes eliminating concerns in secure applications.

9. Can the 7000 Series be used in different types of applications?

Yes. The 7000 Series has 9 inside trim and 11 outside trim functions including classroom security, latch hold back, and electrified functions.
